These things are NOT convictions

- Violations: disorderly conduct, very low-level marijuana possession
- Traffic infractions
- Cases resolved in your favor: adjourned in contemplation of dismissal and then dismissed; declined to prosecute, acquitted
- Juvenile Delinquent and Youthful Offender adjudications do not count, but Juvenile Offender and Adolescent Offender convictions may count, unless the case was decided in family court.

Please note: two convictions from the same incident, may count as one



If the answer is YES

to all questions, you are potentially eligible for criminal record sealing.

If the answer is NO to any question, you are likely not sealing eligible, BUT should still consult with an attorney to double check and explore other options for criminal record relief like Certificates of Relief or Certificates of Good Conduct.
