What are some of the reason why exoffenders return to prison?

- little or no community-based support groups.
- lack of employment, negative social stigmas, and lack of support upon release
- Economic and societal obstacles.
- Poor supervision and discipline, family conflict, family history of problem behavior, parental involvement in and attitudes condoning problem behavior.
- Low income and poor housing.

What supports are provided?

FLIP provides the following supports:

- Emotional Support.
- Alcohol and Substance abuse treatment, Housing, employment/Training, and Health Services.
- Tangible Support.
- Self-esteem or Affirmational Support.
- Belonging Supports.

How can we help?

Our Family support groups are evidence-based practice that offers hope, guidance, advocacy, and camaraderie of ex-offender and their family's post-incarceration, mental health, substance use, and related service systems.
